



Scholarship Announcement: Virtual UN Summer Academy 2022

The 2022 UN Summer Academy will explore sustainable development from a multi-sectoral perspective, focusing on critical themes such as health and well-being, social protection, economic transformation, and climate action. Participants will look at how transformative thought frameworks of systems thinking, futures thinking, and design thinking can address these issues in a complex and volatile context. In order to offer highly qualified candidates the possibility to participate, the state of North Rhine-Westphalia (NRW), Germany, is funding 62 full scholarships, covering fees for the five-day online learning event.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for a scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- have professional or academic experience in the area of sustainable development;
- be able to act as a multiplier, applying and passing on acquired knowledge; and
- be available to actively participate. The virtual Summer Academy is synchronous, meaning participants are expected to be online at the same time during specified hours (either 10:00am to 4:00pm CEST or 2:00pm to 8:00pm CEST) every day, 27 June 2022 till 01 July 2022.

Applicants from NRW and its partner countries and regions are strongly encouraged to apply.
